

**TASKS**

This position has a range of responsibilities and key tasks as follows:

Task
<p><b>Physiotherapist Practice</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Work with local staff and health professionals to assess the physical conditions of residents</li> <li>• Diagnose and plan appropriate patient treatment with local staff and health professionals</li> <li>• Work with the assistance of a translator and/or local partner</li> <li>• Assist local staff and health professionals to train patients to use devices such as walking frames, splints and crutches</li> <li>• Provide training for Anandaniketan staff in manual handling of residents</li> <li>• Provide support and instruction on preparing and maintaining client records and files</li> <li>• Working along side occupational therapists to encourage residents to take part in art, drama or occupational therapy where appropriate</li> <li>• Liaise with other allied health care team members providing expert opinion and advice where necessary and appropriate</li> <li>• Assist local staff and health professionals to produce care plans and risk assessments for individual clients</li> <li>• Record treatment data</li> <li>• Refer to specialised medical services where available and appropriate</li> <li>• Provide own equipment as outlined in pre departure information</li> <li>• Implement policy, as directed by the Team leader, to encourage community participation in aspects of the programme process. This includes educating and training locals in appropriate skill sets that are sustainable in the absence of the Equal Health Team.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Team Meetings</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Attend compulsory de briefing sessions at the end of each day</li> <li>• Attend compulsory briefings held at the beginning of each day</li> </ul>
<p><b>Public Health</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Assist in identifying general public health issues and solutions</li> <li>• Assist in implementing public health treatment such de lousing and other duties under supervision of medical staff</li> </ul>

<p><b>Community Involvement and Socialisation</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Participate in excursions with residents and staff of partner organisations where planned</li> <li>• Socialise with residents and staff of partner organisations after clinical work where possible</li> <li>• Participate in entertainment skits where such activities are provided</li> <li>• Attend concerts, plays and ceremonies organised by in country hosts</li> <li>• Attend formal dinners, functions and ceremonies planned and attended by in country hosts</li> </ul>
<p><b>Logistics</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Assist with recording of daily statistics</li> <li>• Assist with organising equipment for prescribed programmes</li> <li>• Assist in carrying equipment</li> <li>• Set up work environment on a daily basis</li> <li>• Assist all team members as reasonably directed by team leader</li> </ul>
<p><b>Evaluation</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Complete post evaluation questionnaire on the final day of camp</li> <li>• Attend compulsory final allied health debriefing</li> <li>• Attend compulsory final team debriefing</li> </ul>

#### Hours of Work
